## Honey Creek Loop Hike Saturday, July 16 - 7:15 AM - 3:30 PM

Come join your fellow Ski Club members on one of Tennessee's most exciting and challenging hikes! This 6 mile loop may seem like an easy distance, but once you throw in a couple of rock scrambles, some ladders, and a stretch that is actually IN the creek, it's a whole different thing!

We will meet at the Cracker Barrel in Mt Juliet just off I-40 exit 226A at 7:15 AM to leave at 7:30 AM SHARP! It will take about 2.5 hours to reach the trailhead. The hike should take approximately 5 hours with a lunch break, and we should be back to Mt. Juliet by 5:30 PM.

Bring snacks, lunch, and plenty of water! A lot of this trail is exposed so you will get sun, and it will be hot! This hike also requires water shoes for the section that is in the creek.

Sunday we can plan on another short hike after checkout, or head home if you prefer.

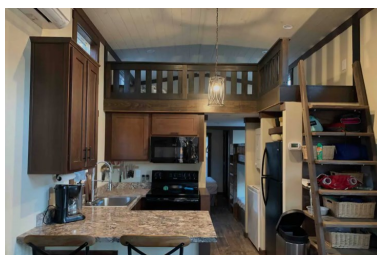
The cost is \$90 per spot with 6 spots available.

I understand the Club acts as coordinator only and accepts no responsibility for the services of any person or agent, ski area, airline or motor coach, hotel or condominium, ski council or association, or any organization whatsoever rendering any of the services or accommodations being offered on any trip or activity. Ski trip and other activity fees are based on current tariffs and are subject to change without notice. The Club accepts no responsibility in whole or in part for any delays, delayed departures or arrivals, missed plane or carrier connections, loss, damage or injury to person or property, mechanical defect or failure of any nature howsoever caused, or for any substitution of hotels or common carrier, with or without notice or for any additional expenses occasioned thereby.
