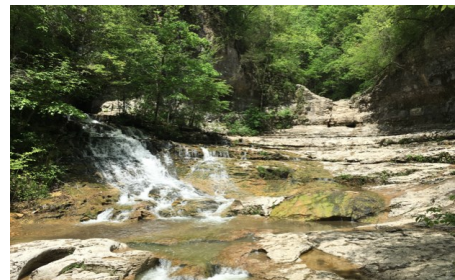

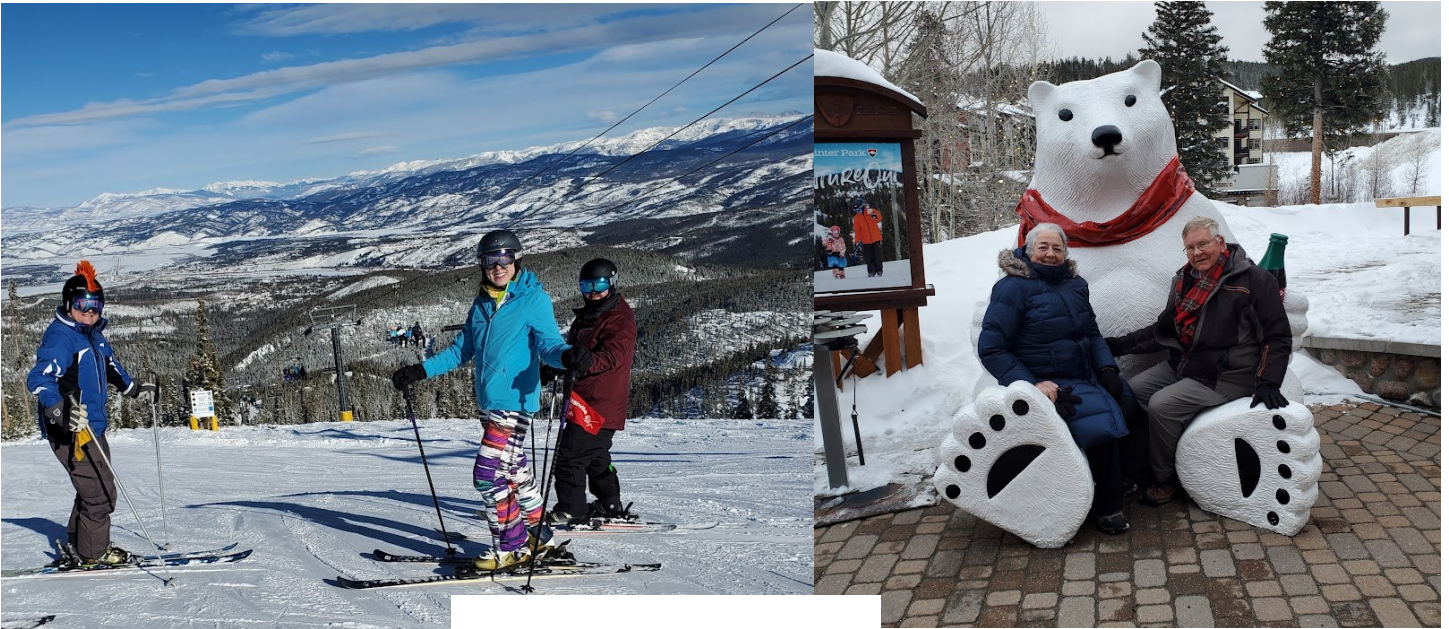


# Winter Park Trip Report

## Telluride, Colorado

### Saturday, February 25 - Saturday, March 4, 2023

It has a total of 120 runs and 2,000+ acres of skiable terrain. 23% of Telluride's runs are ranked at Beginner, 36% Intermediate and 41% Advanced/Expert. Telluride on average receives over 300 inches of snow each winter season.

The resort has been ranked #1 in the annual Conde Nast Traveler's Reader's Choice Survey in 2013, 2014 and 2015.

**Lodging:** [Bear Creek Lodge](#) where we have reserved three 4BR/4BA condos and one 2BR/2BA condo. The property has easy access to the slopes. Each condo includes a gas fireplace and a newly remodeled kitchen with granite countertops and stainless steel appliances.
