


## Weekend Starts on Wednesday Wednesday, July 26 5 PM until ?

LOCATION: Miller's Ale House; 7087 Bakers Bridge Ave; (Cool Springs area) Franklin TN 37067



# Mountain Getaway incl. Ocoee Rafting Saturday-Sunday, August 12-13

Join the NSC for a weekend of rafting the Ocoee River, good food and hiking in Southeast Tennessee. Thanks to one of our members we've been given access to a cabin that sleeps 8 people (double occupancy) only a few minutes from the Ocoee. Cost is \$70 per person, members only. Register and pay on the event page to secure your spot.

The Murphy cabin is a furnished two bedrooms, two baths, media loft (with pullout couch), and a fireplace. A large rear porch overlooks the main creek, and a front porch overlooking a meadow. The cabin is within 20 minutes of north Georgia and southeastern Tennessee, on four acres of land with two creeks and a treehouse. There is a trail next to the tree house to get to the creeks.

With its world-class rapids, the Ocoee River is only 30 minutes away, and Murphy is on the edge of Cherokee and Nantahala National Forests with excellent hiking trails. Additionally, Harrah's has

opened a casino on in Murphy.

#### **Potential Schedule**

#### Saturday August 12

9 AM - Depart Nashville (3 to 3 1/2 hours plus hour time change and 1 hour for lunch probably on around Chattanooga)

2 PM – Raft the middle section of the Ocoee River with the folks from Nantahala Outdoor Center, a 3-3.5 hour guided tour.

Evening - Dinner at Cabin (have grill for cooking out) and a fire pit by the creek. Alternatively, we can go out in Murphy,



there are several good options: The Crown, Chop House, Bistro 29. If there is interest or the fire pit is rained out, there is a Harrah's Casino in Murphy that also has a bowling and arcade center.

#### Sunday, August 13th

We can have breakfast in the cabin and if anyone wants to go for a hike, we can schedule anything from 2-7 miles in the area. One of our favorites is a water fall hike.

Raven Cliff Falls Trail, 4.9 mile and alternatively there is Blood Mountain and Freeman Loop Trail, 5.7 miles,

After the hike, lunch could be at Jim's Smokin Que (really good BBQ) or one of the many restaurants in Helen, GA, which is decorated as an Alpine village (as people in Georgia have envisioned).

After lunch we can go back to the cabin and clean up and head home.

# 2023-24 Trips Announced! Sign-ups begin after July 14 meeting

The NSC is proud to announce our slate of trips for the 2023-24 ski season. While full details will be revealed at our July 14th membership meeting (see page 1 for details) here are a few of the highlights:

#### Park City, UT - January 6-13 - Trip leaders Judy Hall and Tom Gormley

We'll return to Park City for the first time since 2019 and fly into Salt Lake City followed by a motorcoach ride to our condos, which are slopeside at Park City's base. With the addition of Canyons ski area a few years ago, Park City is now the third-largest resort in the US so there's plenty of terrain for all types of skiers. There' are also lots of things to do in the town including visiting the Utah Olympic Park with its museum, sliding track and



aerials practice area. PC's extensive free bus system is easy to navigate. The Epic Pass may be used at Park City.

#### Banff, AB - January 28 - February 4 - Trip leaders Joe Moreau and Bob Beranek



Come ski the Big 3 resorts in Banff: Lake Louise, Banff Sunshine and Mt. Norquay. We'll fly into Calgary for this Sunday-Sunday trip and then travel by motorcoach into the Banff National Park. We'll be staying at a hotel in the town of Banff, breakfast included, which makes available a wide choice of restaurants for your dining pleasure in the evenings. Daily transportation to & from each of the three resorts is also included. The IKON Pass may be used at SkiBig3.

#### Breckenridge, CO - February 24 - March 2 - Trip leaders Sara Tamas Shamblin & David Smith

It's been over a decade since we last ran a trip to Breckenridge, so it was definitely time to return! We'll have ski-in/ski-out condos conveniently located between the mountain and Main Street. We'll fly non-stop to Denver where we'll board a motorcoach for the resort. Taking a day off? There are plenty of other activities available including dogsledding, snowmobiling, ice skating and more. The town's free bus system can help you easily navigate the area. The Epic Pass may be used at Breckenridge.



#### Whitefish, MT - March 9-16 - Trip leaders Tom Gormley and Judy Hall



The last time the club visited this resort it was known as The Big Mountain but in the interim it's seen upgrades to the lifts and the base area. We'll fly into Kalispell and take a motorcoach to our slopeside condos. After a day of skiing among the snow ghosts we can take the shuttle back into the town of Whitefish for its variety of restaurants and entertainment options. Whitefish is an independent resort and several lift ticket options are available when you sign up.
