# Mountain Getaway incl. Ocoee Rafting Saturday-Sunday, August 12-13

Join the NSC for a weekend of rafting the Ocoee River, good food and hiking in Southeast Tennessee. Thanks to one of our members we've been given access to a cabin that sleeps 8 people (double occupancy) only a few minutes from the Ocoee. Cost is \$70 per person, members only. The Murphy cabin is a furnished two bedrooms, two baths, media loft (with pullout couch), and a fireplace. A large rear porch overlooks the main creek, and a front porch overlooking a meadow. The cabin is within 20 minutes of north Georgia and southeastern Tennessee, on four acres of land with two creeks and a treehouse. There is a trail next to the tree house to get to the creeks.

With its world-class rapids, the Ocoee River is only 30 minutes away, and Murphy is on the edge of Cherokee and Nantahala National Forests with excellent hiking trails. Additionally, Harrah's has

opened a casino on in Murphy.


