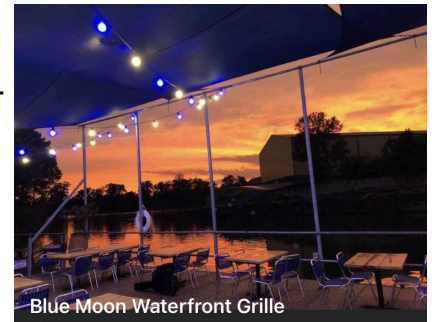

The getaway to the Great Smoky Mountains bestows some of the best fall foliage displays in Tennessee. Join us October 27-29 for hiking, a trout facility tour, moonshine tasting, ski resort trade show with food, wine & beer, and a Halloween DJ costume dance party with dessert, beer and wine. The best time always depends on the weather. Usually, the colors develop in mid-to-late October and peak in early November. The catalyst for the most splendid fall foliage is a string of warm and sunny days followed by cool nights.

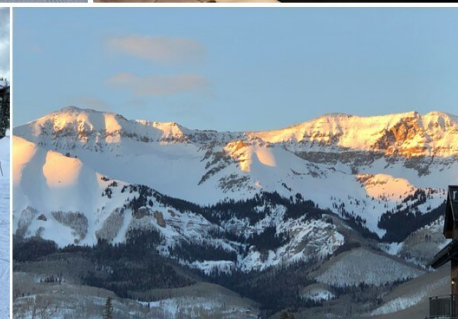

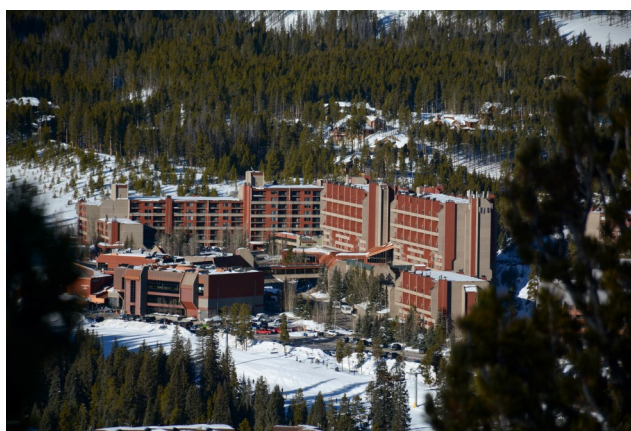

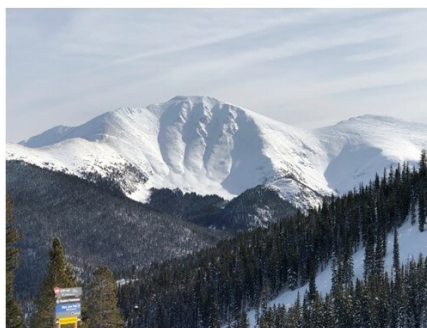
