## Caney Fork River Float Trip – Saturday, June 12, 10am – 3pm

This is a little longer paddle lasting approximately 5 hours (including stopping for lunch). We'll do the Betty's Island Train Bridge trip which will take us under a bridge that was used in The Green Mile movie and we'll cross under the interstate a few times as well. We're using Canoe the Caney for rentals on this trip. They are located about 60 miles East of Nashville near Center Hill Lake. The Caney is a great river for beginners – gentle, wide, scenic. Very family friendly.

- Tandem kayak \$50 per person
- Canoe rental \$35 per person
- BYOB shuttle only \$30



The Caney is a more popular river and can get a bit hectic at check in, so it's recommend we plan on being at Canoe the Caney at 9:15 AM. Like the Duck River trip, pack a lunch and drinks and we'll stop somewhere along the way to swim and eat.
