- 1. **Passport** ensure your passport expires at least 6 months after our trip returns. If your passport expires on or before August 12, 2022 please renew it now. If you have Global Entry ensure it is updated with your latest passport info and expires after February 12, 2022.
- 2. **COVID** requirements are fluid but the process will be much easier if you are vaccinated. It is possible that you will not be allowed into Switzerland (or even on the plane) if you are not fully vaccinated. Please have your vaccination document with you when you travel. The club will not be responsible for ensuring each trip participant meets the requirements for entry.
- 3. Trip Insurance we highly recommend trip insurance, especially for international trips

We are returning to one of the most popular resorts in the United States, Steamboat! Steamboat has been dubbed "Ski Town USA" because it is home to so many Olympic athletes. Steamboat is also famous for its Champagne Powder®, lots of wonderful fluffy powdery snow!

We will be staying at the Storm Meadows condominiums, a ski-in/ski-out property located at the top of the base area. Each unit is 2 bedroom/2 bath, with full kitchen, living area, housekeeping, private shuttle, outdoor hot tub, and of course, free wifi. Pricing is based upon 4 people per unit, 2 people per bedroom. The condos will have a single bed in the master bedroom and either one large bed or two smaller ones in the second bedroom. This Agreement is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 20 ___, by and between the Nashville Ski Club, Inc. and



For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows: I hereby appoint the Nashville Ski Club, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Club") to perform necessary acts deemed desirable in connection with planning and leading any ski trips or other social/activity functions in my behalf. I understand the Club acts as coordinator only and accepts no responsibility for the services of any person or agent, ski area, airline or motor coach, hotel or condominium, ski council or association, or any organization whatsoever rendering any of the services or accommodations being offered on any trip or activity. Ski trip and other activity fees are based on current tariffs and are subject to change without notice. The Club accepts no responsibility in whole or in part for any delays, delayed departures or arrivals, missed plane or carrier connections, loss, damage or injury to person or property, mechanical defect or failure of any nature howsoever caused, or for any substitution of hotels or common carrier, with or without notice or for any additional expenses occasioned thereby.

I fully understand that the Club is a voluntary association run by volunteer officers and Board Members who have no special or professional training in conducting ski trips and other activities. 
